





Palazzo Thiene is described in *The Four Books of Architecture*. But according to a note by the English architect Inigo Jones, who visited the palazzo in 1614 and recorded a story that he heard from Vicenzo Scamozzi, Palazzo Thiene was actually designed by Giulio Romano. Giulio Romano is known to have visited Vicenza in ジュリオ・ロマーノの設計とされる。しかし、 1542 to give his opinion on the Basilica project. It is believed that Romano gave some drawings of Palazzo Thiene to the younger Palladio and that Palladio executed them. In 1546, when the plan needed to be changed, Palladio was put in charge of the revision. The Thiene family was documented in Vicenza for the first time in 1307. Over several centuries, this family accumulated enormous wealth through its landholdings, trading and money lending activities. It occupied important positions in the government, the judiciary, the army, and the church. Moreover, through shrewd marriages, this family succeeded in building up a network of connections with many courts throughout Europe. Two brothers of the Thiene family, Marcantonio and Adriano, were eager to build a princely palace suitable for welcoming their cosmopolitan aristocratic guests, one that would clearly express their political power to the other aristocrats in Vicenza. The brothers began the conversion of their existing Quattrocentesco palazzo into the splendid palazzo that stands today on a huge city block of 54×62 m. But when the son of Marcantonio received the title of Count of Scandiano from Duke of Ferrara in 1565, he moved his residence to Ferrara and lost interest in his project in Vicenza. Therefore only one part of the whole plan was realized.

The present owner is the Banca Popolare di Vicenza, which purchased Palazzo Thiene in 1872, just six years after the bank was established. Today the palazzo houses a small museum with collections of eighteenth-century engravings, twentieth-century sculpture and so on. In 1999 Palazzo Thiene won the "Europa Nostra" award, which recognizes the restoration of historical architecture and its rehabilitation for modern use.



パラッツォ・ティエネは『建築四書』に記載 されているが、1614年にこのパラッツォ訪 れた英国の建築家イニゴ・ジョーンズがスカ モッツィ談として書き留めたメモによると、 1542年にバジリカの助言のために実際にヴ ィチェンツァを訪れていたジュリオ・ロマー ノがパッラーディオにスケッチを渡し、パッ ラーディオが実施設計を行ったであろうと いう推察が散見される。1546年には設計の 変更が求められ、これにはパッラーディオが 全面的にかかわった。

ティエネ家がヴィチェンツァの公式文書に はじめて登場するのは1307年で、数世紀に わたり土地の所有・貿易・金融業および政治・ 司法・軍隊・教会における重要なポストを占 めることによって計り知れないほどの富と権 力を維持し、巧妙な婚姻関係によってヨー ロッパ中の宮廷と通じて強大な派閥を形成 していた。ティエネ家の2人の兄弟(マルカ ントニオとアドリアーノ) は、コスモポリタ

ン的な貴族のゲストを迎えるにふさわし、 かつ市内の貴族にたいして政治的権力を明 確に示すことができる君主的なパラッツ を求めた。1542年に兄弟は既存のクワト ×62mの大きな一区画を占めるパラッツ、 へと変貌させるプロジェクトに着手した。 かし、1565年にマルカントニオの息子がっ ェッラーラ公爵からスカンディアーノ伯爵の 称号を得ると、一族の住まいとともに関心は フェッラーラへと移ってしまい、それゆえま 施されたのは一部のみである。

現在の所有者はポポロ銀行であり、創業6 年にはヨーロッパ文化財アワード (Europa Nostra) を受賞しており、最も優れた歴史的 な建築の修復および現代的な使用による更
